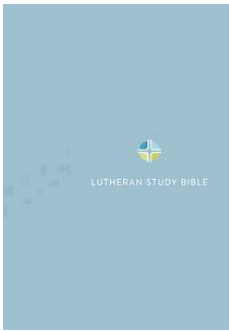


Getting started with the electronic version of *Lutheran Study Bible*



The following chart will help you get *Lutheran Study Bible* (LSB) up and running in the Bible Study App (previously called BibleReader). For more information, video tutorials, user guides, free Webinars, and technical support, visit www.olivetree.com. (On iPhone and iPad, check out the in-app video tutorials available in the **Learning Center** under **My Stuff**.)

Select and install the app	On your computer, go to olivetree.com . Select and download the Windows or Mac version of the app.	On your device, go to the App Store. Select and install Olive Tree Bible+ .	On your device, go to Android Market. Select and install Olive Tree Bible+ .
Purchase LSB	Open the Bible Study App. Under the Store tab in the far left column, click on Book Store . Search for "Lutheran Study Bible." Click on Lutheran Study Bible with NRSV .* Set up an Olive Tree account and make your purchase.	Open the Bible Study App. Tap on Library , then on Store . Tap on Search (at the bottom of the store window) and do a search for "Lutheran Study Bible." Tap on Lutheran Study Bible with NRSV .* Confirm your in-app purchase and enter your Apple ID password.	Open the Bible Study App. Tap on Library , then on Store . Tap on Categories (at the bottom of the store window), then on Study Bibles . Scroll to Lutheran Study Bible with NRSV * and tap on it. Set up an Olive Tree account and make your purchase.
Install/download LSB	Under the Store tab, click on Purchased Books . Click on Install purchased product for Lutheran Study Bible with NRSV .	Tap on Purchased and the download button for Lutheran Study Bible with NRSV .	
Back up and synchronize your work (recommended at the end of each session)	Click on the Olive Tree logo/tab at the top of the screen, then click on Backup and Sync .	Go to My Stuff and tap on Sync (at the bottom of the window).	

*Note: If you have been using the Bible Study App and already purchased the NRSV, the Notes are also available separately.

Add your own notes, bookmarks, and highlights

The Bible Study App allows you to create and save a note, bookmark, or highlight within the Bible text or study notes. There are two ways to go about this within the app:

1. Select a word, phrase, or paragraph in the Bible text or study notes. Use a right-click on a PC or Mac to display a menu of options. On other devices, a menu will pop up automatically as you make your selection.
2. Select a verse number in the Bible text. (As above, use a right-click on a PC or Mac to display a menu of options. On other devices, a menu will pop up automatically as you make your selection.) A note, bookmark, or highlight you add after selecting a verse number will appear in any biblical text you open in the app (including Hebrew and Greek text).

Read and study wherever you are

You can use your electronic version of LSB on up to five devices—any combination of computers, tablets, or smartphones. The first time you use LSB on an additional device, you'll need to download and install it. Open or install the Bible Study App first, then follow the steps below for your device(s):

- On PC and Mac, click on the Olive Tree logo/tab at the top of the screen and go to **Account**. Log in or create an Olive Tree account. Next, go to **Store** and then **Purchased Books** in the left-hand column. Click on **Install Purchased Product** under Lutheran Study Bible.
- On other devices, open the **Library**, then the **Store**, and tap on the **Purchased** tab. (You may be prompted to log into your Olive Tree account during this process.) Tap on the **download** button for Lutheran Study Bible.

If you already created notes, bookmarks, or highlights on another device, go to **Sync** to bring them over to the device you're now using. (You will need to back up and **Sync** your work on the original device, if you haven't done so already.) Using the **Sync** button regularly will prevent you from losing your work as you move from one device to another.



You can also view and edit your work and create new notes from any online platform, whether it's running the Bible Study App or not. Go to www.olivetree.com and select the **Account** tab at the top of the Web page. Log into your account, then select **Olive Tree Study Sync**. Choose **Share** if you'd like to import or export notes.

Tips and tricks for exploring *Lutheran Study Bible* in the Bible Study App

View the NRSV text and related study notes at the same time

Open NRSV in the main window and Lutheran Study Bible in another window to display notes for the passage you're reading.

Find a Bible book, chapter, and verse

Open NRSV in the main window. On a PC or Mac, click on the **Verse Chooser** button  near the top of the screen, or click on the drop-down menu  at the top of the main window and select **Go To**. On other devices, tap on **Go To** at the top of the main window.

Read articles and use other resources

Open LSB in the main window. On a PC or Mac, click on the drop-down menu at the top of the window and click on **Go To**. On other devices, tap on **Go To** at the top of the window. The Table of Contents will display, including introductory articles and a special section on Martin Luther and the Bible. (On tablets and smartphones, you may need to use the **Back** button to get to the full Table of Contents.) For maps, choose **Articles and Resources**. Click or tap again on thumbnail images of maps to enlarge them.

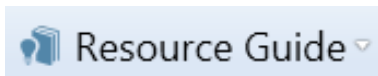
Follow links to related Bible passages and maps

Click or tap on links contained in the study notes (for example, [Luke 2:1](#), [Map 1](#)).

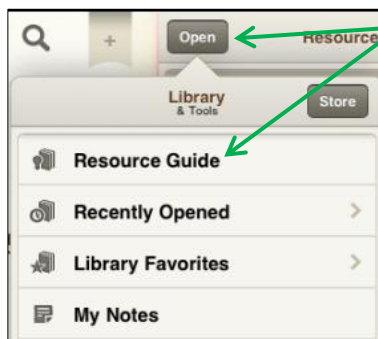
Get more information on people and places

Right-click or tap and hold on a proper name in the Bible text or study notes. On PC and Mac, choose **Look up** to see any related maps or other information. On other devices, choose **More** from the pop-up menu, then **Look up**.

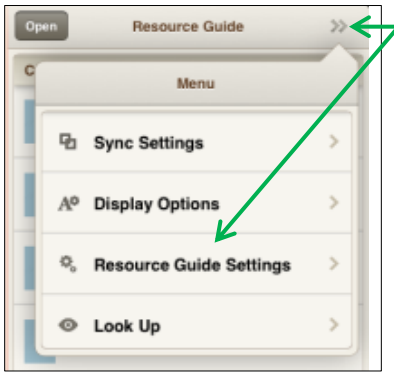
Set up the Resource Guide (available on PC, Mac, iPhone, and iPad)



Open the Resource Guide: On PC and Mac, go to the drop-down menu at the top of the secondary window and select **Resource Guide**.

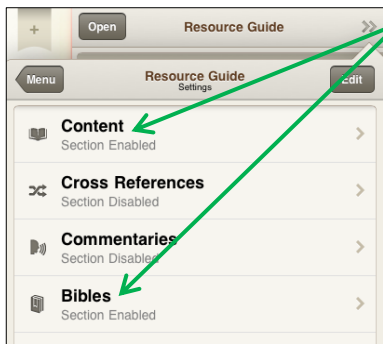


On iPhone and iPad, tap **Open** at the top of the secondary window. Tap on **Resource Guide** in the pop-up window. (The first time you do this, you will be asked whether you want to download the Resource Guide. Tap **Download**.)



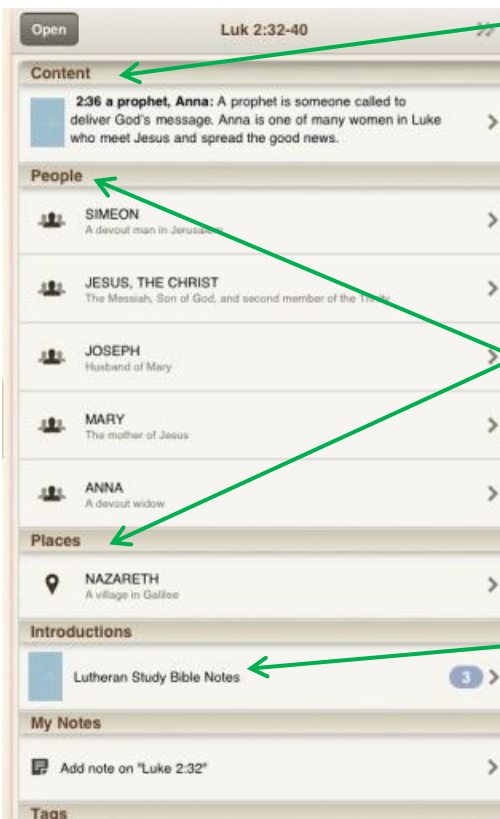
Adjust the Resource Guide settings: On PC and Mac, click on the **Olive Tree logo/tab** at the top of the screen. Select **BibleReader Options**. In the next window, select **Resource Guide**.

On iPhone and iPad, tap on >> in the upper right corner of the Resource Guide window, then choose **Resource Guide Settings**.



Select **Content**. Make sure **Show Content** and **Lutheran Study Bible** are checked or turned on in the next window. Repeat this step in the Resource Guide Settings for People, Places, and Introductions. In the Resource Guide Settings for **Bibles**, make sure **New Revised Standard Version** is checked or turned on.

Open and use the Resource Guide to learn more



Study notes: See the **Content** section for a list of study notes available for the Bible passage. Click or tap on any note you want to read.

More information about a person or place: Click or tap on a name listed under the **People** or **Places** section. The information in the next window will include thumbnail images of any LSB maps associated with that person or place.

Introductions to Bible books and sections: Click or tap on the Lutheran Study Bible icon displayed under **Introductions** for links to introductions to the book of the Bible you're reading and the section of the Bible containing that book, as well as an overview of the Old or New Testament.
